Command Sergeant Major Ronaldo N. Ronsairo enlisted in the United States Army in June 1980 and attended Basic Combat Training at Fort Knox, Kentucky and Advanced Individual Training at Fort Rucker, Alabama.

His initial assignment was with the XVIII Airborne Corps where he served as a flight dispatcher at Simmons Army Airfield. In 1982, he was stationed in Germany with B Company, 8<sup>th</sup> Combat Aviation Battalion where he served as a Flight Operations Specialist. In 1984, he was assigned to Task Force 160 as the Flight Operations NCOIC. In 1987, upon promotion to Staff Sergeant, he was assigned to E Company, 160<sup>th</sup> Special Operations Aviation Group (Airborne) as the Operations NCOIC. In 1990, he was stationed in Panama with B Company, 228<sup>th</sup> Aviation Battalion where he served as a Platoon Sergeant/Operations Chief. In June 1993, he returned to Fort Campbell to rejoin the Night Stalkers as the Regiment S-3 NCOIC and subsequently as the Regiment Operations SGM. In 1997, he was selected to be the First Sergeant of HHC, 1<sup>st</sup> Battalion, 160<sup>th</sup> SOAR (Airborne). In March 1999, he was selected to be the CSM of the Battalion until his departure in July to attend the United States Army Sergeants Major Course. Upon graduating from the Sergeants Major Academy, he was assigned to 2<sup>nd</sup> Aviation Brigade as the Operations SGM. In August 2001, he returned to Fort Campbell and was assigned to 159<sup>th</sup> Aviation Brigade where he served as the Operations SGM. In June 2002, he returned to Korea and served as the Command Sergeant Major of 164<sup>th</sup> Air Traffic Services Group. In January 2007, he served as the Command Sergeant Major for both the Air Traffic Services Command, and the 164<sup>th</sup> Theater Airfield Operations Group, Fort Rucker Alabama. In September 2009 he relinquished the responsibility as the Command Sergeant Major of the Air Traffic Services Command and maintains his position as the Command Sergeant Major of the 164<sup>th</sup> Theater Airfield Operations Group, Fort Rucker, Alabama.

CSM Ronsairo is a graduate of the Command Sergeants Major Course, Sergeants Major Course Class 50, First Sergeant Course, Battle Staff NCO Course, Joint Firepower Course, Advanced Noncommissioned Officer Course, Basic Noncommissioned Officer Course, and Primary Leadership Development Course. He has earned an Associate's Degree in Aircraft Technology from the Philippine School of Aeronautics and a Bachelor of Science Degree in Professional Aeronautics from Embry-Riddle Aeronautical University.

His awards and decorations include the Bronze Star, Meritorious Service Medal with 5 Oak Leaf Cluster, Army Commendation Medal with 4 Oak Leaf Cluster, Army Achievement Medal with a Silver Oak Leaf, Good Conduct Medal, National Defense Service Medal, and the Humanitarian Service Medal. He has earned the Master Aviation Badge, Parachutist Badge, and Air Assault Badge.
